To start, the college saw a 12% increase in enrollment in credit programs over the previous year and awarded over 1,500 awards at the two graduations. SPOTLIGHT ON:

BRANDON'S HOWELL

One could describe Wiregrass Georgia Technical College's Mechatronics student, Brandon Howell, as a modern-day renaissance man. Before Brandon graduated from high school he began his college career with Wiregrass' Dual Enrollment program. Since then he has received an Associate of Applied Science Degree and a Diploma in Commercial Electrical Construction. He has also earned technical certificates of credit in Basic Electricity Technician, Electrical Maintenance Technology, Industrial Electrical Assistant, Industrial Electrician, and Industrial Motor Control Tech.

In December 2023 he graduated with an Associate of Applied Science Degree in Mechatronics Technology. This renaissance man isn't just earning degrees in the advanced manufacturing career field, but he's also taking his education and skills to the next level through an Apprenticeship at Ace Electric. Howell completed his national apprenticeship requirements.


Howell's education, skills, and on-the-job training helped him win gold medals two years in a row at the Georgia SkillsUSA competition in Electrical Construction Wiring. Gold medal winners earn an opportunity to compete at the National SkillsUSA competition, and in the 2022 National SkillsUSA competition, Howell placed 3rd in the nation in Electrical Construction Wiring and competed in the 2023 National SkillsUSA competition again in the same category.

Howell shared, "What I am learning from Wiregrass along with my experience doing an apprenticeship with Ace Electric is setting me up for my future by giving me classroom knowledge that I apply to real-world situations that I come upon on the job. My advisors and instructors at Wiregrass were the ones who encouraged me to compete in Skills USA and they supported me on my journey throughout my competitions. The college has prepared me for the workforce by having excellent instructors and hands-on training utilizing equipment that is used in the industries."






OVERALL ENROLLMENT DATA





Hill added that he feels as an Adult Education teacher he can bring out the best version of every one of his students. Adult Education provides a platform for students to pursue college, military, or better-paying jobs. He represented the college in March at the State EAGLE and Adult Education of the Year reception in Atlanta.

Brooke Cochran of Coffee County was chosen to represent Wiregrass Georgia Technical College as the 2023 annual Dinah Culbreath Wayne Exceptional Adult Georgian in Literacy Education (EAGLE) Student of the Year.

Brooke Cochran was nominated by Adult Education Instructor Sandra Scurry. At the reception, Brooke shared her winning speech about her journey to the adult education program at Wiregrass. Brooke has graduated from high school twice. She received her regular high school diploma, but because she was home-schooled both she and her mom felt it would be best if she also obtained her GED. On April 18 she faced her fears and re-tested for her GED Math. "Math was the only subject I did not pass on the first attempt," shared Brooke. "I could do all the work in class, but testing anxiety hit me like a freight train every time I sat down to test." Test anxiety is nothing new for Brooke, she has battled this ever since middle school and even described it as a monstrous hurdle. Months have passed since her re-test last April and Brooke now stands proudly to share

that she did pass and has earned her GED, and she is currently enrolled as a college student in general studies at Wiregrass Georgia Technical College with dreams to become a speech pathologist one day. The finalists, including the winner, are Brooke Cochran (Coffee County) nominated by Sandra Scurry, Kinely Frazier (Ben Hill County), Jordan Jolly (Berrien County), and Gitthaim Melendez (Lowndes County). Brooke represented the college in March at the TCSG EAGLE and Adult Education Teacher of the Year Reception in Atlanta.
