

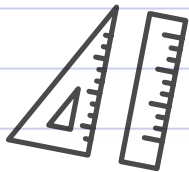
# WHY WIREGRASS DUAL ENROLLMENT?

who participate in Dual Enrollment in high school attend colleges and universities after graduating from high school



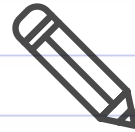
Dual Enrollment students generally have **HIGHER GRADES** in college and persist at greater rates than their traditional peers
