



Basic Life Support CPR Course for Healthcare Providers

Our American Heart Association (AHA) Basic Life Support (BLS) CPR Course for Healthcare Providers is a classroom, video-based, instructor-led class that teaches both single-rescuer and team basic life support. This course trains participants to promptly recognize several life-threatening emergencies, give high-quality chest compressions, deliver appropriate ventilations and provide early use of an AED. Our BLS CPR course teaches skills using the AHA proven Practice-While-Watching technique, which allows Instructors to observe students, provide feedback and guide students' acquisition of skills. This 4 hour course includes Adult, Child and Infant CPR and AED training. A two year AHA certification card is awarded upon completion of the class. American Heart Association Bloodborne Pathogens Course

The American Heart Association Bloodborne Pathogens course is designed to meet OSHA requirements for Bloodborne Pathogens training. The course is taught with an emphasis on protecting yourself from exposure in the workplace; proper reaction procedures; and how to report any exposure in compliance with OSHA regulations. Upon successful completion of this two hour course, students will receive a Wiregrass Completion Certificate. This course is offered by demand. Call 229.333.2122.

HeartSaver CPR/First Aid/AED Course

According to the Occupational Safety and Health Administration (OSHA), approximately 4 million injuries and illnesses occur annually in the workplace and nearly 80% of sudden cardiac arrests occur outside the hospital. AHA HeartSaver CPR/First Aid/AED is a classroom, instructor-led course that teaches students critical skills to respond to and manage a first aid, choking, or sudden cardiac arrest emergency in the first few minutes until emergency medical services arrives. In this course, students learn skills such as how to treat bleeding, sprains, broken bones, shock and other first aid emergencies. This course also teaches adult CPR and AED use. Upon successful completion of the 5 hour course including a skills test, students receive a two year AHA HeartSaver CPR/First Aid/AED certification card. This course offered by demand.
