

Cooperative Degree Agreement
DeVry University
And
The Technical College System of Georgia

General Information:

The cooperative agreement between DeVry University and The Technical College System of Georgia (TCSG) provides students an opportunity to continue their education, and obtain a bachelor's degree from DeVry University, after completion of an Associate of Applied Science degree at Wiregrass Georgia Technical College (WGTC).

Students graduating from Wiregrass Georgia Technical College with an Associate of Applied Science degree in one of the following areas may complete their bachelor's degree program at DeVry University in a like field:

- Accounting
- Biomedical Engineering Technology*
- Computer and Electronics Engineering Technology*
- Computer Information Systems
- Hotel/Restaurant/Tourism Management*
- Management and Supervisory Development (Business Management)
- Marketing Management

Students graduating from Wiregrass Georgia Technical College with an Associate of Applied Science degree in any other field than those listed above, may continue their education at DeVry University and complete the **Bachelor of Science in Technical Management**. Currently, this program requires a total minimum of 122 semester credit hours for graduation. See the DeVry University website for more information.

Guidelines:

- 1) Students must complete at least 25% of their programs' required credit hours, or a minimum of 30 semester credit hours, whichever is greater, through coursework completed at DeVry.
- 2) Students must complete Learning Support, as required for their program.
- 3) Students earning a diploma at Wiregrass Georgia Technical College may then complete the requirements for an Associate of Applied Science degree at WGTC and become qualified for a bachelor's degree program at DeVry University.
