Chamberlain University

RN-BSN (effective August 25, 2020)

This agreement formally recognizes that Chamberlain University (CU) and Wiregrass Georgia Technical College (WGTC) are active educational partners in providing educational opportunities for currently enrolled and potential students of both institutions. Agreement to this partnerships requires commitment by both institutions to serve and facilitate a student's ability to transfer into a degree program without jeopardizing the mission and stated goals of either institution.

This agreement is specifically for students who have completed the Associate of Science in Nursing program at WGTC. Also, the agreement applies to any WGTC faculty and employees who wish to further their education.

Conditions of Transfer:

- 1. Applicant must be a graduate from WGTC with an Associate Degree in Nursing (ASN).
- 2. Applicant must be a registered nurse with a current, active Registered Nursing (RN) license in the U.S. or in a jurisdiction that is an associate member of the National Council of State Boards of Nursing (NCSBN).
- 3. A conferred ASN degree and proof of an RN license may allow students to be awarded up to 77 credit hours through the Chamberlain University Articulation Plan (CCAP). This includes 37 liberal arts and sciences credits and 40 nursing credits.
- 4. Applicants must have a minimum cumulative grade point average of 2.0 on a 4.0 scale.
- 5. Applicants must meet all Admissions standards set forth by CU. However, the terms of this agreement allow the application fee to be waived.
- 6. 100% online of the programs available through this agreement are offered online.
