## Columbia Southern University

Business Management Course Requirements (effective October 13, 2022)

This agreement provides students who have earned an **Associate of Applied Science degree** at Wiregrass Georgia Technical College (WGTC), which is accredited by the Commission of Colleges (COC of the Southern Association of Colleges and Schools (SACS), the opportunity to continue their education by transferring into Columbia Southern University's (CSU) Bachelor of Science in Business Administration (BS BA).

Graduates and employees of the Wiregrass Georgia Technical College who enroll in any Columbia Southern University bachelor's degree program are eligible to participate in the Leadership Partnership between CSU and WGTC. The benefits of this partnership include students, employees, and their families receiving a 10% discount in tuition.

Admissions and Matriculation - WGTC students will be afforded the same treatment and protection, and be required to meet the same admissions requirements, as native Columbia Southern University students enrolled under a specific catalog term. WGTC students should request an official transcript be sent to Columbia Southern University upon completion of coursework at Wiregrass Georgia Technical College. A minimum grade of "C" in all courses must be maintained to qualify for transfer under this articulation agreement.

Transfer of Credit - Direct transfer credit for a Major Requirement or General Education course requires the transfer course to be a minimum of 3 semester hours. Any WGTC course worth 4 or more semester hours but only given 3 semester hours for chart purposes would be reviewed for the full credit designated by WGTC, subject to program director approval. Actual number of transfer credit hours awarded (and therefore the number of hours to be completed at CSU) will be based on actual courses completed successfully at WGTC for which there exists a CSU equivalent and could be more or less than the number of transfer credits in the example above. Please note, CSU accepts a maximum of 90 semester hours of transfer credit in the bachelor's degree program. WGTC's ECON 2105 or ECON 2106 must be completed as a WGTC Social/Behavioral Sciences-General Core Courses for possible transfer credit to CSU's ECO 2301 or ECO 2301 in Major Requirements.
