

FALL SCHOLARSHIPS

ACE Electric AMPED Scholarship

Provides a \$500 scholarship to a Lowndes High School graduate enrolling at Wiregrass Georgia Technical College in the Commercial Industrial Electrical Construction Program.

Adel-Cook County Chamber of Commerce Scholarship

Provides \$500 divided over two consecutive semesters for a student at the Cook County Workforce Development Center who is a resident of Cook County.

Requirements: Must have a minimum GPA of 2.0 and be enrolled on the Cook campus, must also reside in Cook County.

Ben Copeland Sr. LPN to RN Bridge Scholarship

Provides up to \$5,000 divided over a maximum of three semesters (\$1,000 first and second semester & up to 3,000 for third semester) to a Wiregrass student enrolled in the LPN to RN Bridge program.

Requirements: Must have a minimum GPA of 2.5 and be enrolled on the Valdosta campus.

Clarence Smith Memorial Scholarship

Provides up to \$2000 divided over three consecutive semesters for a student on the Valdosta or Cook Campus in any program of study.

Requirements: Must have excellent work ethics. Work Ethics grade will be reviewed. Preference is given to students who resided at Georgia Sheriff's Boys Ranch in Hahira.

Coyote Manufacturing Scholarship

Provides \$500 scholarship to be presented in full for one welding and joining student per semester

Requirements: Must be a full-time student with a minimum GPA of 2.0 enrolled in the Welding and Joining program.

Farmers and Merchants Bank

Provides a \$2,500 scholarship to be divided over a maximum of five semesters.

Requirements: Must be a full-time student with a minimum GPA of 3.0. Open to any Wiregrass student in any program.

Nadeen Green & Ned Cone Scholarship

Provides a \$500 scholarship to be presented in full to a student in any Technical & Industrial program on the Valdosta campus

Requirements: Must be enrolled in six credit hours and must have and maintain a minimum GPA of 3.0. Two letters of recommendation are requested

Premium Peanut LLC Scholarship

Provides \$500.00 for one semester to any student in the Wiregrass service area/

Requirements: Must have a minimum GPA of 2.0 and must be enrolled in Industrial Systems, and his/her parent is an employee or shareholder of Premium Peanut. If none of these apply, then it is open to any WGTC Student in IST.

Renasant Bank of Valdosta Scholarship

Provides \$500 for one semester for a student enrolled in a business program on the Valdosta or Cook campus.

Requirements: Must be enrolled full-time and in his/her senior year. Must have a minimum GPA of 2.5.
